Into the Desert

Lent invites us into a different rhythm—one that is slower, quieter, and more honest. This year, we step into Lent through the wisdom of the Desert Mothers and Fathers, early Christian seekers who withdrew into the desert not to escape the world, but to encounter truth more fully. For them, the desert was not a place of emptiness, but of clarity: a landscape where distractions fell away and the heart could be laid bare before God.

In the starkness of the desert, there was nowhere to hide. The Desert Mothers and Fathers learned that transformation does not come through spiritual striving or impressive discipline, but through attentiveness—listening deeply to God, to oneself, and to the realities of human weakness and longing. They discovered that God meets us not when we have perfected ourselves, but precisely as we are.

This Lent, we are invited into that same posture. Rather than measuring success by what we give up or achieve, we are called to stillness, to patience, and to courage. Lent becomes a space to sit with our struggles, resist easy answers, and allow God's presence to do its quiet work. In the desert, change happens gently, honestly, and from the inside out.
